The Director of the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development, Division of Banking and Securities (“Administrator”), has conducted an investigation into certain activities of TMTE, Inc., aka Metals.com, Walter Vera, Athena Hunter, Sean Reza, Jonathan Sachs, David Bleeden, and Randall Kohl (collectively “Respondents”).

Respondent Hunter agrees that the Administrator has jurisdiction over Hunter and these matters under the Alaska Securities Act (AS 45.56 et seq) (the “Act”).

As evidenced by the authorized signature on this Consent Agreement (“Agreement”), Respondent Hunter consents to the entry of this Agreement. Respondent Hunter waives her right of appeal under AS 45.56.230(d).

The Temporary Cease and Desist Order Effective Immediately, Assessing Civil Penalties and Notice of Final Order (“Order”) entered on July 20, 2020 is hereby withdrawn as to Respondent Hunter only, and replaced with this Agreement. The terms of this Agreement are as follows:

1. Respondent shall not act as an investment adviser representative, agent, or a

1 supervised person, or to otherwise solicit on behalf of a broker-dealer or investment adviser,  
2 under the Act unless Respondent first obtains any and all required licenses.

3 2. Respondent forfeits any right to contest, challenge, or appeal the denial of an  
4 application for registration as an investment adviser representative, agent, or supervised person  
5 under the Act if such denial occurs before the expiration of this agreement.

6 3. Respondent shall not violate the Act or associated regulations.

7 4. Upon a violation of this Agreement by Respondent, the Administrator, in its discretion,  
8 may either (1) impose a \$10,000 penalty for the violation; or (2) revoke this consent decree,  
9 re-impose the Order, and seek a final order based upon the violations of the Act alleged in the  
10 Order. This paragraph shall not be interpreted to prohibit the Administrator from filing a  
11 separate criminal, civil, or administrative action (or order) for any new violations of the Act.

12 5. This Agreement shall not be construed as an admission by Respondent or as a  
13 finding that Respondent violated the Act.

14 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Agreement is a public record under Alaska law, that  
15 the Administrator shall comply with all public records laws, and that this Agreement will be  
16 viewable on the Administrator's website.

17 7. This Agreement expires on January 1, 2025.

18 8. The parties agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the State of Alaska Superior Court for  
19 the purposes of any future disputes that arise between the parties that concern this Agreement,
