## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Kivalina Strategic Management Plan Community Participation and Input Report Phase I, describes the first phase of community participation and input. The information gathered and expressed in this report is for use in HDR's development of a Background Planning Report and eventually the Strategic Management Plan for the Native Village of Kivalina.

## 2. COMMUNITY BACKGROUND SURVEY

Administered by the Kivalina Community Coordination, the Community Background Survey introduced the Strategic Management Plan project to community members, assessed their knowledge of previous planning activities and helps the Project Team understand the needs and concerns of the community. A copy of the Community Background Survey can be found under Attachment A.

Date of Surveying: April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2015 – May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015

Number of Respondents: 100

The following are the results of the Community Background Survey:

**a. QUESTION: How long have you lived in Kivalina?**

Respondents were asked to report their specific age. Age ranges were created to identify trends.

*FINDING: Most of the respondents have lived in Kivalina for over 45 years.*

**b. QUESTION: How concerned are you about erosion, flooding, and severe storms in Kivalina?**

Respondents were asked to choose their level of concern from the 4 options reported below.

*FINDING: Over half of the survey participants are very concerned about erosion.*

*FINDING: Most survey participants have some knowledge of the Evacuation Road project.*

**d. QUESTION: What are your biggest concerns about erosion, flooding, thawing permafrost and severe storms in Kivalina?**

Respondents were asked to fill in answers to this open ended question. Responses were summarized into areas of concern.

*FINDING: Survey participant's top three concerns are (1) Rapid loss of land in the village, (2) the danger and effects of flooding and (3) safety of community members, particularly elders and youth.*

**e. QUESTION: What issues regarding erosion, flooding, thawing permafrost, severe storms, and other climate change impacts should be considered in the SMP?**

Respondents were asked to fill in answers to this open ended question. Responses were summarized into issue areas.

*FINDINGS: Survey participant's top three considerations for the development of the SMP were (1) the development on an evacuation route out of the community to higher, safer ground, (2) relocating the community to higher, safer ground and (3) developing an evacuation plan to be fully prepared at the time of an evacuation. Many survey respondents saw the need for both the evacuation route in the short term, and relocation in the longer term.*

The following are the results of the Community Values Survey:

**a. QUESTION: Gender**

Respondents were asked to check their gender.

*FINDING: The split between male and female survey participants are nearly equitable.*

**b. QUESTION: Age**

Respondents were asked to report their specific age. Age ranges were created to identify trends.

*FINDING: The majority of survey participants were between the ages of 18-35. This indicates that a number of participants in the values survey were different from those that participated in the Community Background Survey, where 33% of participants had lived in Kivalina 45 years or longer.*

Respondents were given a list of 21 values and asked to pick the 10 important to them. In addition, respondents were able to add values that did not appear on the list.

*FINDING: Over 90% of survey participants agreed that Family was their top value. 88% of participants agreed that Elders were their second most important value and 87% of participants agreed that Subsistence was their third most important value*

**d. QUESTION: “The three things I would like to see happen to make Kivalina an even better place to live would be....”**

Respondents were asked to fill in a response to this open ended question. The data and findings below reflect a summary of those responses.

*FINDING: Survey respondents most typical answers were (1) running water and sewer in the community, (2) a new school, (3) space for more housing and relocating the village to safer, higher ground. Since these were narrative answers, they are not tabulated by a percentage as the totals reflect the number of times the topic was mentioned in survey responses. However, it is worth noting that the top ranking response – water and sewer – was mentioned 57 times across 82 survey responses.*

#### 4. ELDER INTERVIEWS

In order to ensure the input of the community elders in the Strategic Management Plan process, the Kivalina Community Coordinator interviewed a selection of Elders from the community. The format of the interviews was meant to prompt a conversation to be recorded or noted. An overview of the respondent's comments is provided as the information is not as easy to metrically record. A copy of Elder interview questions can be found in **Attachment A.**

Date of Surveying: April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2015 – May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015

Number of Respondents: 12

Elder Interview Summary:

*12 Elders were interviewed between the ages of 60 and 72 years old. Of the elders not born in Kivalina, most moved to the village because their family was originally from there, they married someone from the village or they came for the plentiful subsistence lifestyle the area offered. Of those elders who were in Kivalina as a child, they remember a clean, safe village that was quiet and fun. They appreciated the tight knit community and the abundance provided by subsistence from both the land and sea. One elder commented that people in Kivalina were "always smiling". Many remember a much larger beach and wider swath of land between the ocean and lagoon. They remember more open space, with fewer houses and an overall less crowded feeling. Their vision of the future is better living conditions for the next generations – more homes, water and sewer, new school, etc. Some hoped that the village relocated out of harm's way. Others hoped that the community would work together and continue the subsistence lifestyle.*

#### 5. CLASSROOM EXERCISE

Although no classroom exercise was completed in the community, there were an abundance of children present at the community gathering.

## **6. COMMUNITY GATHERING (94 Participants)**

In addition to introductions and a project overview, the Project Team gathering input to identify and prioritize the community's top issues and values. A copy of the Community Gathering Agenda, the meeting flyer, meeting graphics and Sign-In sheet can be found under **Attachment A**.

The 94 participants recorded on the sign in sheet include both children and adults. Both children and adults were offered the opportunities to identify their top issues and values. Many of the Community Gathering participants completed the Community Background Survey.

### **a. Community Issues:**

In order to confirm the community's top issues, a portion of the meeting was devoted to establishing and prioritizing community issues. The Project Team presented a list of issues identified through research, the background planning report and community surveys. Meeting participants were asked to add any additional issues not already identified and the Project Team recorded these issues on large pieces of paper at the head of the meeting room. With all issues identified, the Project Team asked participants to individually rank their top three (3) by putting check marks by the three most important issues on the list.

*FINDINGS: According to the independent voting at the Community Gathering, the top three issues identified by meeting participants were (1) Need Sewer and Water, (2) Lack of Employment and (3) Need for a Library<sup>1</sup>. These top priorities correlate very closely with the top three things that Value Survey participant's identified as things that would improve the community.*

*At one point during the meeting, an elder mentioned that the community simply needed to build the evacuation road, build the school and relocate the community. There was informal consensus among the crowd of gathering participants.*

The following findings and data have been synthesized to eliminate duplication or group similar ideas together. Note that each participant was given the opportunity to select their three highest ranking issues, however the total votes shown in the tables below reflect that not all meeting participants voted.

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<sup>1</sup> Many of the children participation in the meeting voted for a library. The 4<sup>th</sup> issued identified was the need for a Village Public Safety Officer.

**b. Values**

A portion of the meeting was used to rank the community's values. The list of values from the Values Survey was used to start the values discussion. Items were added to the list and meeting participants voted on their top values.

*FINDINGS: According to the independent voting at the Community Gathering, the top value identified by meeting participants was (1) Need Sewer and Water. Three values tied for second place, (2a) Relocating the Village, (2b) Traditional Culture, (2c) Keeping the Village Clean. Other values that received more than one (1) vote, included (3a) Respect for Elders, (3b) Friends, and (3c) Jobs and Economic Opportunities. The prioritize Values varied from those established by the community survey, but follow the results of the three things that would improve Kivalina.*
