Note: You can expect an election to occur (assuming that the LBC approves the petition) about 120 days after the written decision is mailed.*

<u>Wednesday, September 11, 2013</u> Acceptance of Edna Bay city incorporation petition

<u>Wednesday, September 18, 2013</u> Notice published. Petition's public comment period starts (*lasts 63 days - must last at least 49 days*).

<u>Wednesday, September 18, 2013</u> Send notice of public information meeting to petitioner, and petitioner's posting of that notice

Wednesday October 2 and October 9, 2013 Publish notice of public information meeting

Thursday, October 10, 2013 Public information meeting

<u>Wednesday, November 20, 2013</u> Petition public comment period deadline

<u>Thursday, December 5, 2013</u> Deadline to receive petitioner's reply brief (*lasts at least 15 days – must last at least 14 days*).

<u>Friday, December 6, 2013</u> Start writing preliminary report *(68 days to write preliminary report)*

Wednesday, February 12, 2014 Finish and mail preliminary report

<u>Thursday, February 13, 2014</u> Public comment on preliminary report period starts (*lasts 32 days - must last at least 28 days*).

Monday, March 17, 2014 Preliminary report public comment period deadline

<u>Tuesday, March 18, 2014</u> Start writing final report (*31 days to write final report*)

<u>Wednesday, April 9, 2014</u> Public hearing notice published (done 35 days before hearing - must precede the hearing by at least 30 days).

Friday, April 18, 2014

Mail final report (*done 26 days before hearing – must precede the hearing by at least 21 days*).

Wednesday, May 14 – Thursday May 15, 2014

LBC public hearing and decisional meeting in Edna Bay, Alaska (*decisional meeting must* be within 90 days of the hearing, but can immediately follow it. The Edna Bay decisional meeting will immediately follow the hearing.).

<u>Friday, May 16, 2014</u> Start drafting final decision

Wednesday, May 28, 2014

Decision drafted and sent to commissioners (13 days from decisional meeting.)

Wednesday, June 4, 2014

LBC meeting to approve/disapprove written decision (20 days from the decisional meeting – decision must be issued within 30 days of decisional meeting).

Thursday, June 5, 2014

If approved, decision mailed to parties (21 days after decision. That starts the 18 day period for public to request reconsideration of decision. LBC has 30 days on its own motion to reconsider. If reconsideration is granted, then petitioner or respondent has 10 days to file a brief).

*(Friday, October 3, 2014 is 120 days after June 5, 2014)
