

CURRENT COMMUNITY CONDITIONS: FUEL PRICES ACROSS ALASKA NOVEMBER 2008 UPDATE

Introduction



In June 2008, Alaska North Slope (ANS) crude oil reached a record average monthly price of \$133.78 per barrel (Figure 1). Recently, the price of ANS crude has dipped under \$40 per barrel, its lowest price since early 2005. While the national per gallon average price of gasoline dropped 54 percent from its peak in early July to the end of November (from \$4.11 to \$1.89) and heating fuel prices dropped 26 percent from early October to the end of November (from \$3.66

to \$2.71)¹, Alaska has not experienced the same level of decline. Due to transportation issues, many remote rural Alaska communities purchased most or all of this winter's fuel at peak prices during June and July. These communities are unlikely to see price relief until the middle of 2009.

A recent study by the Institute of Social and Economic Research (ISER)² indicates low-income households in remote rural Alaska may be paying up to 41 percent of their income on home energy use, compared to four percent for the average Alaska household. Heating fuel prices have gone up significantly in remote rural Alaska since the release of the ISER study, so the percent of total income rural Alaskans will spend on home energy use will also likely increase. Additionally, the cost of goods, services, and subsistence activities are disproportionately high in remote regions due to the direct impact of high fuel costs on transportation and basic survival needs.

During October 2008 and November 2008, the Division of Community & Regional Affairs (DCRA) repeated a statewide survey of retail heating fuel and gasoline prices in a cross-section of 100 select Alaska communities first initiated during 2005 (*Community Conditions: Fuel Prices Across Alaska*). This report, *Current Community Conditions: Fuel Prices Across Alaska, November 2008 Update* summarizes fuel survey findings, discusses changes in fuel prices during the recent past, and provides a current and historical perspective of fluctuating fuel prices. Of critical importance, this report details fuel prices in each community on the date of contact.

Methodology

The DCRA Research and Analysis Section and Local Government Assistance Section, developed the survey and selected a community sample during 2005. Communities were strategically selected to represent differing socioeconomic conditions and all Alaska regions including the Interior, North Slope, South Coastal, Southeast, and Western regions. Selected communities had also generally been the recipient of an Alaska Energy Authority bulk fuel project during the recent past.

Since a non-probability sampling method was utilized, this survey is considered a non-scientific study with results not generalizable to the entire population of rural Alaska communities. To accurately and consistently track longitudinal changes in fuel prices, the 2005 survey and



community sample were used to collect 2006, 2007, and 2008 fuel information – the communities and core questionnaire items remained the same from 2005 to 2008.

DCRA Research and Analysis staff conducted surveys between October 13 – 16, 2008 and November 24 – 28, 2008. In total, local fuel retailers serving 100 communities were contacted (via telephone) and requested to provide current heating fuel (#1) and gasoline per gallon prices. Survey results are one-time measurements and representative of retail fuel prices on the particular day of contact. Heating fuel and gasoline prices may have changed between the time of contact and publishing of this report.

Current Fuel Prices across Alaska



Average heating fuel prices per gallon vary across Alaska by region (Figure 2). Western Alaska communities report the highest average heating fuel retail price at \$6.99 per gallon while North Slope communities report the lowest average retail price at \$1.80 per gallon. Of noteworthy

importance, the North Slope Borough provides free heating fuel for residential use through village corporations who distribute fuel to residents throughout the Borough, charging only a delivery fee on a per gallon basis. The North Slope Borough does not subsidize heating fuel for commercial use. Consequently, heating fuel retail price for commercial entities is significantly higher than residential use heating fuel (Table 1). Compared to other regions, excluding the North Slope, Interior communities experience relatively lower heating fuel prices at an average price of \$4.84 per gallon.


To accurately summarize statewide heating fuel prices, it is appropriate to exclude North Slope Region communities due to the North Slope Borough subsidy for residential use heating fuel. When considering statewide heating fuel prices, the Arctic Village Traditional Council in Arctic Village (Interior Region) reports the highest heating fuel retail price at \$9.00 per gallon (see Appendix). In contrast, Alaska Petroleum in Fairbanks (Interior Region) reports the lowest heating fuel retail price at \$2.63 per gallon. On average, heating fuel retails for \$5.85 per gallon across the 93 surveyed Alaska communities (excluding North Slope Region communities).

As Figure 2 illustrates, average gasoline prices per gallon also vary across Alaska by region. Western Region communities report the highest average gasoline retail price at \$6.76 per gallon while Southeast communities report the lowest average retail price at \$4.71 per gallon. Statewide retail prices indicate significant variation in gasoline retail price. Specifically, the Arctic Village Traditional Council in Arctic Village (Interior Region) and Nunamiut Corporation in Anaktuvuk Pass (North Slope Region) report the highest gasoline prices at \$9.00 per gallon. In contrast, Alaska Petroleum in Fairbanks (Interior Region) reports the lowest gasoline retail price at \$2.75 per gallon. On average, gasoline retails for \$5.97 per gallon across 98 Alaska communities.


Change in Fuel Prices across Alaska

Portions of Alaska have begun to realize fuel price relief. Excluding North Slope Region communities, the statewide average per gallon heating fuel price decreased from \$6.05 to \$5.85 from October 2008 to November 2008. This \$0.20 per gallon average price decrease represents a three percent decrease in statewide average heating fuel per gallon price. Prices in the Interior (-9%), South Coastal (-7%), and Southeast (-8%) regions decreased during the past month. The Western Region experienced a one percent price increase.

The statewide average per gallon gasoline price decreased from \$5.97 to \$5.80 from October 2008 to November 2008. This \$0.17 per gallon average price decrease represents a three percent decrease in statewide average gasoline per gallon price. Prices in the Interior (-9%), South Coastal (-5%), and Southeast (-8%) regions decreased during the past month. Prices in the North Slope Region increased three percent. Western Region prices increased by less than one percent.




Despite this recent decline, prices increased significantly over the past year (Figure 3). Excluding North Slope Region communities, the statewide average heating fuel price increased from \$4.32 per gallon to \$5.85 per gallon during November 2007 to November 2008. This \$1.53 per gallon average price increase represents a 35 percent increase in statewide average heating fuel per gallon price (Figure 4). Prices have increased over the past year by one-quarter in the Southeast (30 %) and South Coastal (29 %) regions, and by nearly half (48 %) in the Western Region.



The statewide average gasoline price also increased from November 2007 to November 2008, from \$4.54 to \$5.80 per gallon (Figure 5). This \$1.26 per gallon average price increase represents a 28 percent increase in the statewide average gasoline per gallon price. The average price per gallon for gasoline increased between one-fifth and one-third in all regions, with the greatest increase occurring in the Western Region (32 %).

Notably, monetary increases in price per gallon for heating fuel and gasoline from the one-year period spanning November 2007 to November 2008 were nearly double the increases from the two-year period spanning November 2005 to November 2007. From November 2007 to November 2008, the statewide average price of heating fuel increased by \$1.53 per gallon, compared to an increase of \$0.84 per gallon from November 2005 to November 2007. Similarly, from November 2007 to November 2008, the statewide average price of gasoline increased by \$1.36 per gallon, compared to an increase of \$0.71 per gallon from November 2005 to November 2007.



Consumer Demand

Retailers were queried regarding whether market demand for heating fuel or gasoline had generally increased, decreased, or remained the same during the past 12 months (Table 2). Demand for heating fuel remained generally steady statewide, with half (47 %) of respondents reporting no change in demand. Slightly more vendors report a decrease (29 %) than an increase (24 %) in demand.

Demand for gasoline likewise remained generally steady statewide, with half (47 %) of respondents reporting no change in demand; however, the number of respondents reporting a decrease (33 %) in demand exceeded the number reporting an increase (20 %). Half of all respondents in the Interior (47 %) and Southeast (50 %) regions report a decrease in demand for gasoline. Respondents in these regions anecdotally indicate demand has decreased due to a cutback in recreational gasoline use, such as passenger car driving, boating, snow machine, and ATV use.

Fuel Delivery Schedule

The frequency of fuel delivery to rural communities in Alaska is highly dependent upon geography and infrastructure. Not surprisingly, fuel vendors in road system communities generally receive frequent (sometimes daily) deliveries, while vendors located along the western and northern coasts of Alaska or roadless river communities receive shipments via barge during periods when shipping routes are free from ice. Other coastal communities generally receive weekly to quarterly fuel shipments.

Local fuel vendors were asked about the general frequency of bulk fuel deliveries in their communities (Table 3). Communities along the Richardson, Glenn, and Parks highways receive the most frequent shipments. Coastal Alaska communities in the Southeast Region, Kenai Peninsula, Kodiak Island, and Cordova receive regular shipments with frequencies generally ranging from weekly to quarterly. Alaska roadless river communities, communities along Alaska's west and north coasts, and the Aleutian and Pribilof islands receive shipments between late May and mid-October, dependent on when fuel barges have access to the communities.



Volume Discounts on Heating Fuel

Fuel vendors nationwide commonly offer volume discounts on residential heating fuel. This allows residents to realize a cost savings by purchasing fuel in bulk. In Alaska, volume discounts offer modest price relief to residents in communities where such discounts are available. Of the 93 fuel vendors surveyed (excluding the North Slope Region), 24 vendors (26 percent) offer volume discounts (Figure 6). Generally, vendors require a minimum purchase of 100 to 200 gallons to receive a discount; however, the minimum volume discount ranges from 50 gallons to 500 gallons.



Volume discounts are more prevalent in larger and/or more accessible communities. In the Southeast Region, where most communities have regular barge service, two-thirds (64 %) of fuel vendors offer volume discounts. Only five Western Region vendors (13 %) offer volume discounts, two of whom serve the regional hubs of Kotzebue and McGrath. Generally speaking, residents of remote rural Alaska communities have the least opportunity to benefit from volume purchases of residential heating fuel.

Summary

While Alaska North Slope crude oil prices have dropped significantly during the past few months, Alaskans have continued to pay high prices for heating fuel and gasoline. As the price of crude oil continues to drop, communities along the road system and in temperate coastal regions are beginning to experience price relief; however, due to transportation issues, many remote rural Alaska communities purchased most or all of this winter's fuel at peak prices during June and July.

From October 2008 to November 2008 the statewide average per gallon price of heating fuel decreased three percent from \$6.05 to \$5.85. During the same period, the statewide average per gallon price of gasoline decreased three percent from \$5.97 to \$5.80. Despite recent declines, from November 2007 to November 2008 the average per gallon price of heating fuel increased 35 percent from \$4.32 to \$5.85, and the average per gallon price of gasoline increased 28 percent from \$4.54 to \$5.80.

In the Western Region, average per gallon heating fuel prices are \$6.99 and average per gallon gasoline prices are \$6.76. Additionally, vendors in this region are the least likely to extend volume discounts on residential heating fuel purchases and will not receive regular fuel shipments until the middle of 2009. Should Alaska North Slope crude oil prices continue to remain low, fuel price relief for this region, and for other remote rural Alaska communities, is likely to occur in the middle of 2009.


