Disaster Recovery Action Plan

The State of Alaska is looking for **your feedback** on how to use federal disaster recovery funding to **help address damage** from the 2024 flood in Juneau and help **prepare the community** for future disasters.

WHAT IS THE RECOVERY ACTION PLAN?



THE FLOOD

In August 2024, a severe glacial lake outburst flood affecting Mendenhall Lake and River caused damage to homes and infrastructure, and disrupted the local economy. The unprecedented scale of the disaster triggered the release of federal aid, including assistance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).



THE FUNDING

The funding from HUD is being administered by the State of Alaska's Division of Community & Regional Affairs (DCRA). The state must submit a recovery action plan to HUD outlining how the funds will be used before the funding is released. There is about \$6 million available to address Juneau's unmet recovery and mitigation needs that haven't been addressed by other funds.



THE PLAN

The plan was submitted to HUD in December 2025. It included an overview of unmet recovery needs, potential future hazards, and broad outlines of how funding may be used to address unmet recovery needs and protect against future disasters. Examples include repairing damage to homes, installing flood protection devices, and hazard planning.

Now we need to refine how the funds will be used, and we need your help.

Should the money be spent on home repairs? Flood barriers? Hazard planning? Social services? Something else?
