If you have concerns about going to the poll on Election Day because of COVID-19 for the upcoming municipal election, there are alternative ways you can vote. For example, you can vote early in person or request to receive a ballot in the mail. The poll(s) will still be open on Election Day, but in a time of social distancing one of these options might be better for you.
