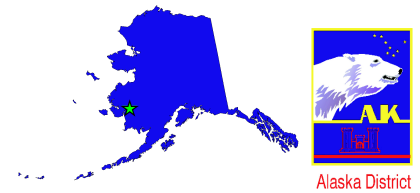

Floodplain Notes: Flood of record occurred in 1964. Estimated elevation of 35.2 ft (based on flood gage). Approximate elevation is 27.61 ft based on DCRA Community Profile Map datum.

NWS flood gage: "A" marker on the slope gage is a brass cap on a steel rod at the streamward, upstream corner of Mary Jackson's home. A NWS staff gage is on the same corner. The elevation of the "A" marker is 30.81 ft. (Add 19.05 ft to the staff readings to correlate to the slope gage data.)

The flood gage was installed on the Akiak library. High Water Elevation (HWE) signs were also placed on utility poles adjacent to the road between the high school and the library about 300 and 500 yards upstream of the high school. HWE signs were placed on the shoreward, downstream corner of the library and on the shoreward, downstream corner of the old BIA school. Flooding occurred in 1920, 1964, 1971, 1982, 1984, 1987 and 1988, 2009.
