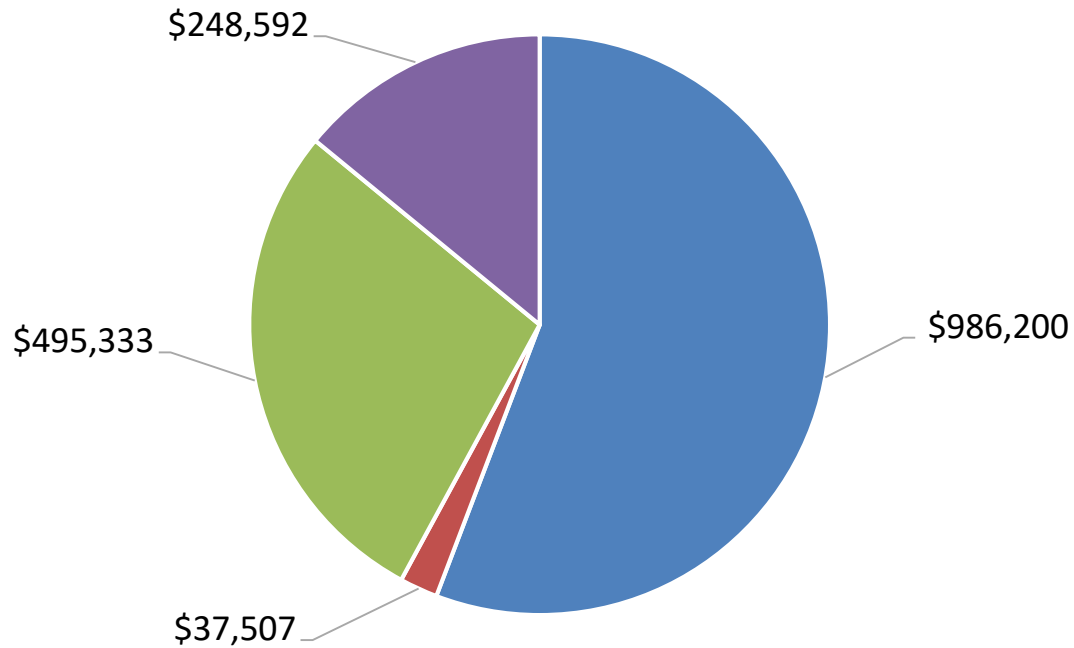

- **\$1,767,632 awarded across ten grants since July 2018**
- **Five other declined and pending projects**

# HUD

- \$449,000 ICDBG Imminent Threat
  - Boat and hovercraft landing replacement
- \$537,200 CDBG
  - Land use planning for managed retreat



# BIA

- \$131,586 FY18 Tribal Resilience
  - Environmental risk assessment
- \$53,992 FY18 Erosion/Climate Response
  - Relocate six buildings
  - Travel to the National Adaptation Forum
- \$148,350 FY19 Tribal Resilience
  - Hire a part-time Managed Retreat Coordinator
  - Collect data to inform erosion and flood threats with DGGS
  - Engineering technical assistance



# BIA continued

- \$149,996 FY19 Tribal Resilience
  - River morphology study
  - Produced a managed retreat work plan
- \$11,409 FY 19 Tribal Resilience
  - Travel to an interagency meeting



# Denali Commission

- \$248,592 Village Infrastructure Protection Program
  - New subdivision layout, survey, platting



# Natural Resources Conservation Service

- \$37,507 Emergency Watershed Protection Program
  - Relocate city garage and fire station
