State of Alaska Local Boundary Commission (LBC) Notice of Decisional Meeting Regarding the Soldotna Annexation Petition

The LBC staff final report concerning the legislative review annexation petition for the City of Soldotna was released on July 20, 2020. The City of Soldotna proposes to annex approximately 2.63 square miles of land in the unincorporated portion of the Kenai Peninsula Borough. The report recommends that the LBC approve the annexation petition. The LBC can approve, amend, or deny the petition. If the LBC approves the petition, it will submit its decision to the Legislature during the first 10 days of a regular session. If the Legislature does not disapprove the decision, the boundary change takes effect 45 days after submission.
