CERTIFICATE

of

Reclassification of the City of Russian Mission

By the power and duty vested in me under the laws of the State of Alaska, I, Mike Navarre, Commissioner of the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development, hereby issue this certificate of reclassification for the second class City of Russian Mission. On September 10, 1972, Russian Mission was reclassified as a second class city.¹ This certificate replaces the certificate recorded November 10, 1970, with a recording number of 70-28.

¹ The City of Russian Mission was duly incorporated as a fourth class city effective October 28, 1970. On September 10, 1972, fourth class cities incorporated before that date were reclassified as second class cities. The City of Russian Mission was not issued a new certificate at the time.

The boundaries of the City of Russian Mission are described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Section 26, Township 20 North, Range 67 West, projected, Seward Meridian, Alaska;
thence due South approximately 2 1/2 miles to a point at the quarter corner on the west boundary of Section 2, Township 19 North; Range 67 West;
thence due East approximately 2 1/4 miles to where this line intersects the West shore of Circle Slough of the Yukon River in Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 66 West;
thence in a general northerly direction approximately 3 1/3 miles along the west shore of Circle Slough and the Yukon River to the point where the North boundary of Section 25, Township 20 North, Range 67 West, intersects the West Shore of the Yukon River;
then due west approximately 1 1/3 miles to the point of beginning being an area containing 5 3/4 square miles, more or less.

All land is located within the Bethel Recording District, Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska.
