I have been a fisherman at Ekuk for 50 years and my wife for over 30 years. I am writing to oppose the proposal to annex Ekuk to Dillingham. We do not use the suggested City of Dillingham facilities that are being put forth in the proposal. We use the Dillingham airport on the trip to Ekuk but we also use the Anchorage airport. 90% of our supplies and groceries are barged directly to Ekuk. We purchase occasional groceries and truck parts from Dillingham but that in itself is a boost to the City of Dillingham economy not a drain that needs to be offset by taxation.

I wish I had time to address these issues more thoroughly but I hope this gives you the just of my concerns. On the behalf of myself and my wife Renee Rasco please give this consideration as you move forward with your decision.
