
RE: Report on the Local Boundary Commission: Proposed Borough

The Traditional Council of Togiak opposes the formation of a borough in the Dillingham census area. The Traditional Council of Togiak is the second largest tribe in the Bristol Bay region and the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest community within the Dillingham census area. The recommendation by the local boundary commission to impose a borough on our people will not benefit the people, the culture, or the economy in the community of Togiak.

The Traditional Council of Togiak and its boundaries opts to remain a second class city and does not support the planned proposed borough recommended by the Local Boundary Commission, the City of Dillingham, or the City of Manokotak.
