KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH'S SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS REGARDING THE PRELIMINARY REPORT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, DIVISION OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS ("DCRA")

The Kenai Peninsula Borough ("KPB") hereby files some additional information regarding personnel with the LBC in the above-captioned matter. The petition for the formation of City of Nikiski ("CON") as a home rule city states that the employees of the current North Peninsula Recreational Service Area ("NPRSA") and Nikiski Fire Service Area ("NFSA") will become employees of the city with the same salary and benefits. There are between 32 and 68 employees, depending upon the season, which would be transitioned to the CON, and at least 16 stipend emergency response volunteers. [Ex. Y] NFSA has 21.75 employees (18 hourly fire/rescue, 1.75 administrative assistants, and 2 management) and 16 stipended emergency response volunteers. NPRSA has between 17 and 46 employees on the payroll depending upon the season, (9 hourly bargained, between 7 and 36 temporaries, and 1 management). [Ex. Y] 29 of the current employees of both groups combined are covered by the collective bargaining agreement.

As the borough submitted in its opening brief, the economies of scale will make it more expensive to provide services for the CON than for the borough through its service areas. The cost of providing the "same salary and benefits" to a separate pool of employees

will not be equal to what it is for the service areas today because the cost of accounting, payroll and related support is covered by the general fund not the service area. The service areas are also supported by the general fund and general government departments which include, but are not limited to, the purchasing, human resources, finance, technology, land management, emergency management and legal departments.

Negotiating health and welfare benefits in a smaller risk pool and administering those benefits will cost much more per hire for a smaller entity to provide. It is unlikely that the CON could accept the risk of being self-funded, which would add cost to providing the benefits through an insurer directly. Leave such as AFMLA (Alaska Family and Medical Leave Act) and FMLA (Family and Medical Leave Act), workers compensation, and ADA (Americans with Disability Act) and related accommodations will also have to be provided.

Insurance such as general liability and workers' compensation would likely be more expensive as the CON would not have the negotiated coverage of the borough's larger pool consisting of the school district and borough. CON should anticipate a higher cost due to its small size in the market and the types of facilities they would be insuring such as the emergency response facilities and recreation/pool facilities.
