Local Boundary Commission (LBC)
Notice of extension of written public comment and Resume
Decisional Meeting Regarding the Soldotna Annexation Petition

The LBC has relaxed its procedural regulations per 3 AAC 110.660 to allow for a 7-day written public comment period to consider whether to convert the City of Soldotna's annexation petition from the legislative review method to the local action method. All written public comments must be submitted to the local boundary commission by no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, October 27, 2020. Comments may be sent to lbc@alaska.gov. No oral public testimony will be accepted during the decisional meeting.

The commission initiated a decisional meeting under 3 AAC 110.570 on August 5, 2020. The August 5, 2020 meeting was recessed to the call of the Chair. The decisional meeting was resumed on October 20, 2020 at 10:00 and subsequently recessed to the call of the Chair. The decisional meeting will again resume on Thursday, October 29, 2020 at 10 a.m.

The LBC can approve, amend, or deny the petition. If the LBC approves the petition, it will submit its decision to the Legislature during the first 10 days of a regular session. If the Legislature does not disapprove the decision, the boundary change takes effect 45 days after submission.
