I, HUGH J. WADE, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY FIND, CERTIFY AND DECLARE THAT, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 2.12(d) and 2.12(f) of Chapter 146, Session Laws of Alaska, 1961, as amended, an election for the incorporation of a second class borough known as the Bristol Bay Borough was held on October 2, 1962, within the boundaries of said proposed borough, and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation.

I DO HEREBY FURTHER DECLARE THAT the Bristol Bay Borough is an organized borough and a municipal corporation;


THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for boroughs of the second class by Chapter 146, Session Laws of Alaska, 1961, as amended;

THAT the borough seat is Naknek and the boundaries of the said borough are:

Beginning at a point which is located at 58 degrees, 53 minutes, 9 seconds North Latitude and 157 degrees, 02 minutes, and 45 seconds West Longitude (Coast and Geodetic Survey Marker, Russ.); thence East to a point 156 degrees, 18 minutes, 50 seconds West Longitude; thence South approximately 21 miles to a point at 58 degrees, 37 minutes North Latitude; thence West approximately 61 miles to a point at 158 degrees West Longitude; thence North approximately 3 miles to the point of intersection with the North Shore of Kvichak Bay; thence meandering approximately 38 miles in a northeasterly direction along the North Shore of Kvichak Bay to the point of beginning.
