CERTIFICATE

BOUNDARIES OF THE NORTH SLOPE BOROUGH

I, Emil Notti, Commissioner of the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs, hereby certify that the following is a true and correct description of the jurisdictional boundaries of the North Slope Borough. The boundaries described below reflect the detachment of approximately 3,298 square miles from the southwest portion of the borough.

This certificate is issued to correct a ministerial error in the certificate of boundaries executed June 4, 1986. The error is contained on the fortieth line of the description, which is changed in this description from:

"Township 32 North; Range 7 West, (KRM): thence", to read:

"Township 32 North; Range 7 East, (KRM): thence",

The record of the proceedings of the Local Boundary Commission leading to the issuance of this certificate clearly indicate, without question, the intent reflected by this revised certificate of boundaries.

Beginning at a point in the Chukchi Sea where the westerly extension of the protracted northern boundary of Township 30 North, Range 29 West, Kateel River Meridian (approximate latitude 68 degrees 2 minutes 7.56 seconds North) intersects the westerly boundary of the State of Alaska; thence in an easterly direction along the westerly extension of the protracted northern boundary of Township 30 North, Range 29 West, Kateel River Meridian (KRM) to its intersection with the mean high tide line of the Chukchi Sea; thence continuing easterly to the protracted Northwest corner of Township 30 North, Range 25 West, (KRM); thence northerly to the protracted Northwest corner of Township 32 North, Range 25 West, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Southeast corner of Township 33 North; Range 18 West, (KRM); thence northerly to the protracted Northwest corner of Township 33 North; Range 17 West, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Northeast corner of Township 33 North; Range 15 West, (KRM); thence southerly to the protracted Southeast corner of Township 33 North; Range 15 West, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Southwest corner of Township 33 North; Range 12 West, (KRM); thence northerly to the protracted Northwest corner of Township 33 North; Range 12 West, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Northeast corner of Township 33 North; Range 11 West, (KRM); thence southerly to the protracted Southeast corner of Township 33 North; Range 11 West, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Southwest corner of Township 33 North;

Range 6 West, (KRM); thence northerly to the protracted Northwest corner of Township 33 North; Range 6 West, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Northeast corner of Township 33 North; Range 5 West, (KRM); thence southerly to the protracted Southeast corner of Township 33 North; Range 5 West, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Northeast corner of Township 32 North; Range 7 East, (KRM); thence southerly to the protracted Southeast corner of Township 32 North; Range 7 East, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Northeast corner of Township 31 North; Range 11 East, (KRM); thence southerly to the protracted Southeast corner of Township 31 North; Range 11 East, (KRM); thence easterly to the protracted Northeast corner of Township 30 North; Range 15 East, (KRM); thence southerly to 68 degrees North Latitude; thence easterly along the 68 degrees North Latitude line to 146 degrees West Longitude; thence northerly along 146 degrees West Longitude to 68 degrees 30 minutes North Latitude; thence easterly along 68 degrees 30 minutes North Latitude to the boundary common to the United States and Canada; thence northerly along the boundary common to the United States and Canada to its intersection with the mean high tide line of the Beaufort Sea; thence continuing northerly along the boundary common to the United States and Canada in the Beaufort Sea to the northerly boundary of the State of Alaska in the Beaufort Sea; thence westerly, northwesterly, westerly, southwesterly, southerly, and southeasterly along the boundary of the State of Alaska in the Beaufort Sea, Arctic Ocean, and Chukchi Sea to a point in the Chukchi sea at its intersection with the westerly extension of the protracted northern boundary of Township 30 North, Range 29 West, Kateel River Meridian (approximate latitude 68 degrees 2 minutes 7.56 seconds North), the point of beginning, containing 84,983 square miles, more or less, all in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska.

The boundaries described above became effective June 2, 1986 following the approval of the detachment by the Second Session of the State Legislature on March 9, 1986 and the subsequent incorporation of the Northwest Arctic Borough on June 2, 1986.

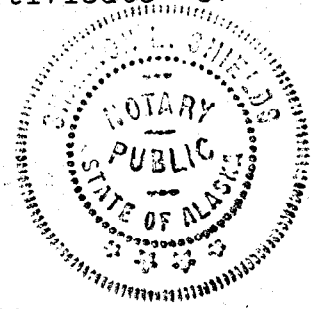
