CERTIFICATE

I, ROBERT W. WARD, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022, an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Akiak, Alaska, was held on June 23, 1970, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Akiak is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the SE Corner of Section 5, T9N, R67W (projected), Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence North to the NE corner of Section 32, T10N, R67W; thence West to a point on the center of the North boundary of Section 31, T10N, R67W; thence South along the center line of Section 31, T10N, R67W, and the center line of Section 6, T9N, R67W, to a point on the South boundary of Section 6, T9N, R67W; thence East to the point of beginning, containing 3.0 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on June 23, 1970, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
