
CERTIFICATE OF BOUNDARIES

CITY OF ANIAK

I, David G. Hoffman, Commissioner of the Alaska Department of Community & Regional Affairs, hereby certify that the following is a true and accurate description of the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Aniak, an Alaska municipal corporation. The boundaries described below reflect all changes to the boundaries of said city including annexation of approximately 2.75 square miles of territory authorized by the Alaska Local Boundary Commission on June 14, 1988, approved by a majority of the voters voting on the question in a local election conducted October 4, 1988, and effected January 18, 1989.

Beginning at the NW Corner of protracted Section 3, Township 17 North, Range 57 West, Seward Meridian (S.M.); thence south to the SW Corner of the N 1/2 of protracted Section 10, Township 17 North, Range 57 West, S.M.; thence east to the SE Corner of the N 1/2 of protracted Section 10, Township 17 North, Range 57 West, S.M.; thence south to the SW Corner of the N 1/2 of protracted Section 14, Township 17 North, Range 57 West, S.M.; thence east to the SE Corner of the N 1/2 of protracted Section 18, Township 17 North, Range 56 West, S.M.; thence north to the NE Corner of the S 1/2 of protracted Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 56 West, S.M.; thence west to the NW Corner of the S 1/2 of protracted Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 56 West, S.M.; thence north to the NE Corner of protracted Section 1, Township 17 North, Range 57 West, S.M.; thence west to the NW Corner of protracted Section 3, Township 17 North, Range 57 West, S.M.; the point of beginning, containing 8.5 square miles more or less.

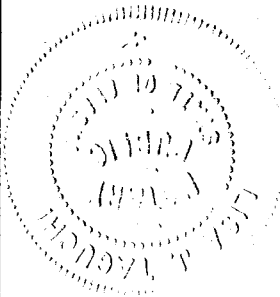

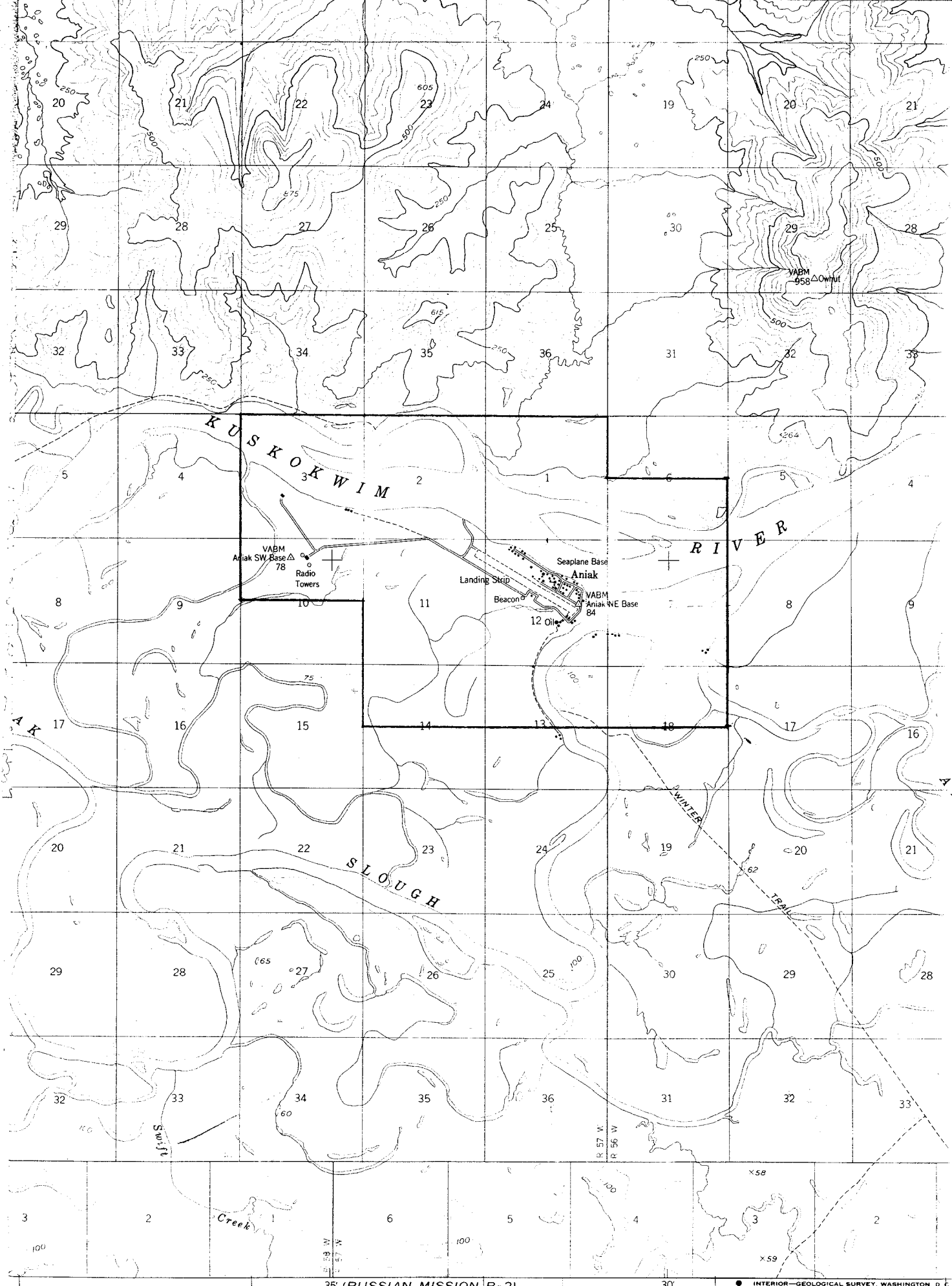
