CERTIFICATE

I, ROBERT W. WARD, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022 an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Anvik, Alaska, was held on September 23, 1969, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 32 for and 0 against.

AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast for enactment of a 2% sales tax. The vote was 21 for and 12 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Anvik is incorporated as a fourth class city with authority to enact a 2% sales tax;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Section 18, T30N, R58W, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence South to the southwest corner of Section 7, T29N, R58W; thence East to the point where the south boundary of Section 8 intersects the meander of the westerly bank of the Yukon River; thence northerly along said meander to the point where the east boundary of Section 29, T30N, R58W intersects the said meander of the westerly bank of the Yukon River; thence North to the northeast corner of Section 17, T30N, R58W; thence West to the point of beginning, containing 12 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on September 23, 1969, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

- Theodore R. Kruger
- Nellie Wharton
- Thomas Wood


AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.


