

In the Matter of the Incorporation of the
community known as Eagle City, Alaska.

ORDER and
Declaration of
Incorporation and
Election of Officers.

We, the undersigned, L.C. Hess, L.P. Merriman and J.B. Howard, duly appointed by the order of the Judge of the United States District Court for the District of Alaska, Third Division, to constitute a board of election under whose charge and control should be held an election to determine the proposition whether the community known as Eagle City, Alaska, shall incorporate under the name and within the boundaries set out in said order, and to elect officers of such corporation, hereby certify

That pursuant to the order of said Court, on the eighth day of January, 1901, between the hours of 2 P.M. and 8 P.M. at Heath's Hotel, in said Eagle City, after taking the oath of office prescribed by said court we entered upon the performance of our duties and during said time continually attended to said election; that to the best of our knowledge and belief every elector whose ballot was received and cast upon the proposition of incorporation is the owner of substantial property interests in the proposed corporation and that all electors who voted at said election possessed the qualifications required by law.

That upon a canvass of the votes cast upon the several subjects voted upon, we find that more than a two-thirds majority of the votes cast upon the proposition to incorporate, were in favor of such proposition, and we do therefore hereby

ORDER AND DECLARE

that the community heretofore known as Eagle City, in the District of Alaska, is duly incorporated under the name and style of Town of Eagle, within the following boundaries;—Beginning at a point where the center line of C street and the Yukon River intersect, thence running in a southwesterly direction along the center line of said C street for a distance of two hundred (200) rods; thence southeasterly three hundred and twenty (320) rods on a line at right angles to said C street; thence in a northeasterly direction parallel to and with said C street to the left bank of the Yukon River; thence along the left meander line of said river in a northeasterly direction to place of beginning; containing approximately four hundred (400) acres.

We further find that the seven following named persons received the highest number of votes cast for members of the common council of said corporation, and do therefore hereby

ORDER AND DECLARE

James Schouyeauille, A.L. Heath, B.D. Mills, L.P. Merriman, J.C. Myers, L.C. Hess and J.H. Crook the duly elected councilmen of the corporation known as the Town of Eagle.

We further find that the three following named persons received the highest number of votes cast for directors of the school board of said corporation, and do therefore hereby

ORDER AND DECLARATION

V.L. Bevington, S. Widman and L.C. Hess the duly elected directors of the school board of the corporation known as the Town of Eagle.

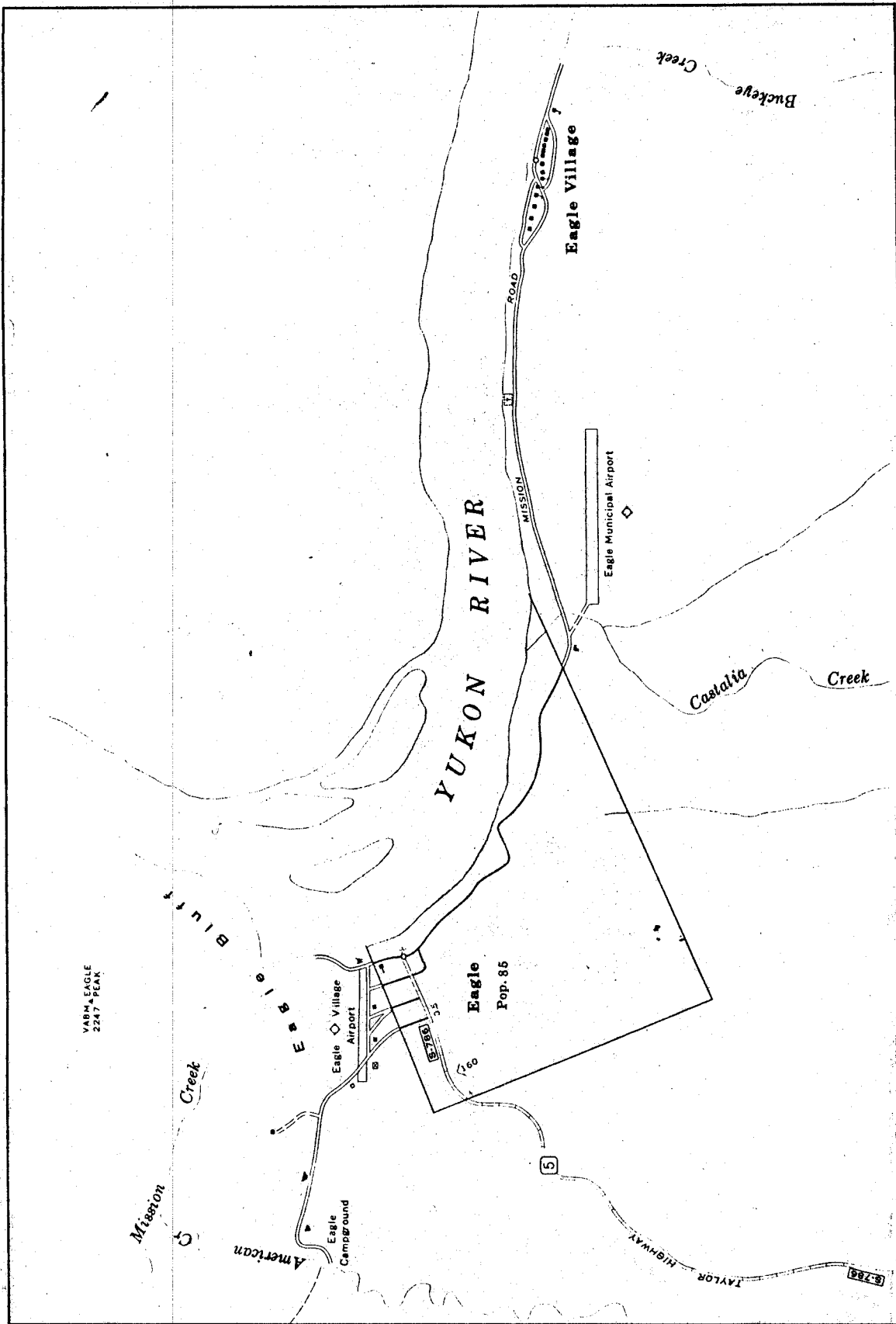
