CERTIFICATE

I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 15.15.450, 29,18,120 an election for the incorporation of a second class city known as Kobuk, Alaska, was held on September 25, 1973, within the boundaries of said proposed area for the incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 17 for and 2 against.

AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast against enactment of a 3% sales tax. The vote was 16 against and 2 for.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Kobuk is incorporated as a second class by Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the southwest corner of the northwest 1/4 of Section 5, unsurveyed T17N, R9E, Kateel River Meridian, Alaska; thence east to the southeast corner of the northeast 1/4 of Section 2, T17N, R9E; thence north to the southeast corner of the northeast 1/4 of Section 14, T18N, R9E; thence west to the southwest corner of the northwest 1/4 of Section 17, T18N, R9E; thence south to the point of beginning containing 16 square miles, more or less.


