# CERTIFICATE

I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 15.15.450, 29,18,120 an election for the incorporation of a second class city known as Koyukuk, Alaska, was held on September 25, 1973, within the boundaries of said proposed area for the incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 34 for and 2 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Koyukuk is incorporated as a second class city by Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Section 6, unsurveyed T7S, R6E, Kateel River Meridian, Alaska; thence east to the point where the north boundary of Section 3, T7S, R6E intersects the west bank of the Yukon River; thence following the meander of the west bank of the Yukon River in a southwesterly direction to its intersection with the west boundary of Section 19, T7S, R6E; thence north to the point of beginning, containing 7.6 square miles, more or less.


