CERTIFICATE

I, ROBERT W. WARD, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022, an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Napakiak, Alaska, was held on October 6, 1970, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 43 for and 8 against.

AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast against enactment of a 3% sales tax. The vote was 10 for and 41 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Napakiak is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES:

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at a point where the East Boundary of Section 17, R72W, T7N, Seward Meridian, Alaska, as projected intersects the meander of North bank the Kuskokwim River; thence N to the NE corner of Section 17, R72W, T7N; thence West to the NW corner of Section 13, R73W, T7N; thence South to the point where the West boundary of Section 25, R73W, T7N intersects the meander of the North bank of the Kuskokwim River; thence in a northerly and easterly direction along the meander of the Kuskokwim River to the point of beginning; containing 5.2 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on October 6, 1970, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
