CERTIFICATE

I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 15.15.450, 29.18.110 and 29.18.120 an election for the incorporation of a second class city known as New Stuyahok, Alaska, was held on September 26, 1972, within the boundaries of said proposed area for the incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 33 for and 15 against.

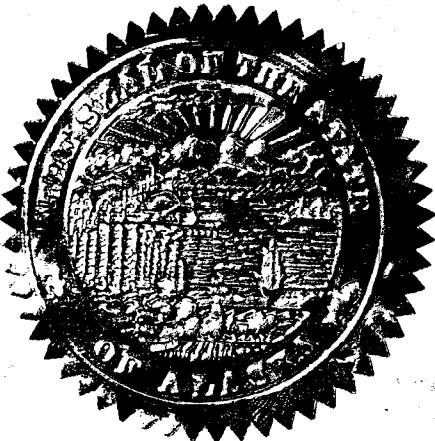
AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast against enactment of a 2% sales tax. The vote was 38 against and 10 for.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of New Stuyahok is incorporated as a second class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the second class by Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the SE corner of Unsurveyed T8S, R47W, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence North to the NE corner of Unsurveyed T8S, R47W; thence West to the NW corner of Unsurveyed T8S, R47W; thence South to the SW corner of Unsurveyed T8S, R47W; thence East to the point of beginning, containing 36 square miles, more or less.

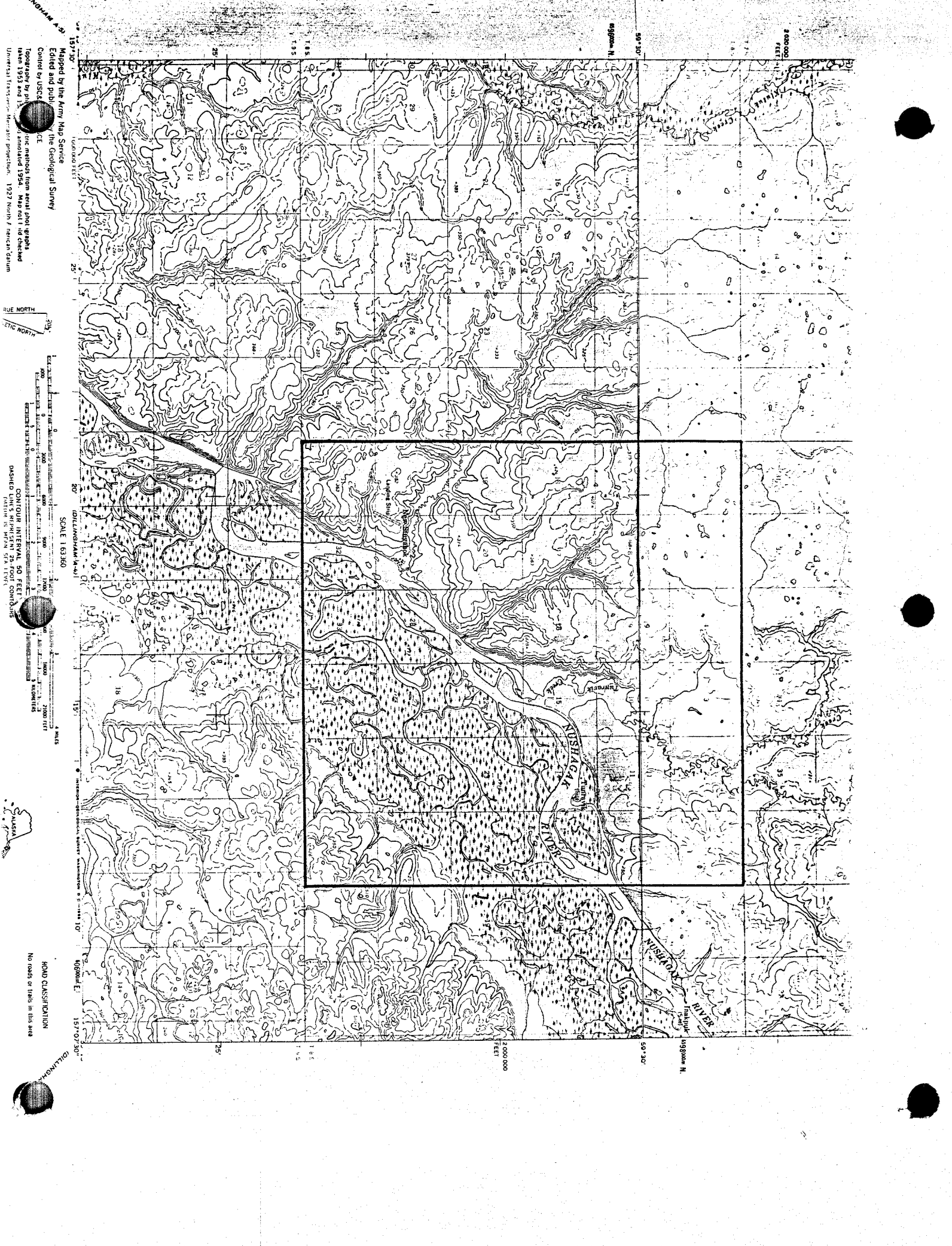

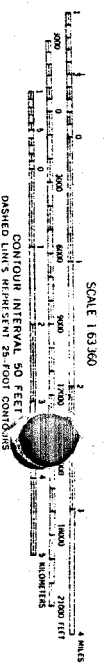
