I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022, an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Newhalen, Alaska, was held on September 14, 1971, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Newhalen is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the SW corner of Section 29, Unsurveyed T5S, R33W, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence E to the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 27, Unsurveyed T5S, R33W; thence N to the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 22, Unsurveyed T5S, R33W; thence E to the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 23, Unsurveyed T5S, R33W; thence N to the NW corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 23, Unsurveyed T5S, R33W; thence E to the NE corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 23, Unsurveyed T5S, R33W; thence N to the NE corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 14, Unsurveyed T5S, R33W; thence W to the NW corner of the SW 1/4 of Section 17, Unsurveyed T5S, R33W; thence S to the point of beginning, containing 8.5 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on September 14, 1971, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council;

- Sava Anelon
- Alex Wassillie
- Steven Wassillie

AND THAT Peter Olympic, Mary Wassillie, Wassie Nicholie and Peter John are tied for fourth and fifth places on the city council and the successful candidates are to be determined by lot.

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.

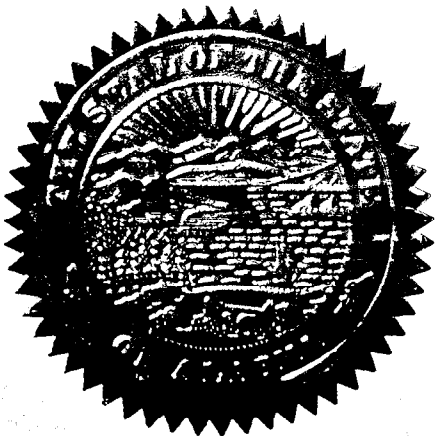



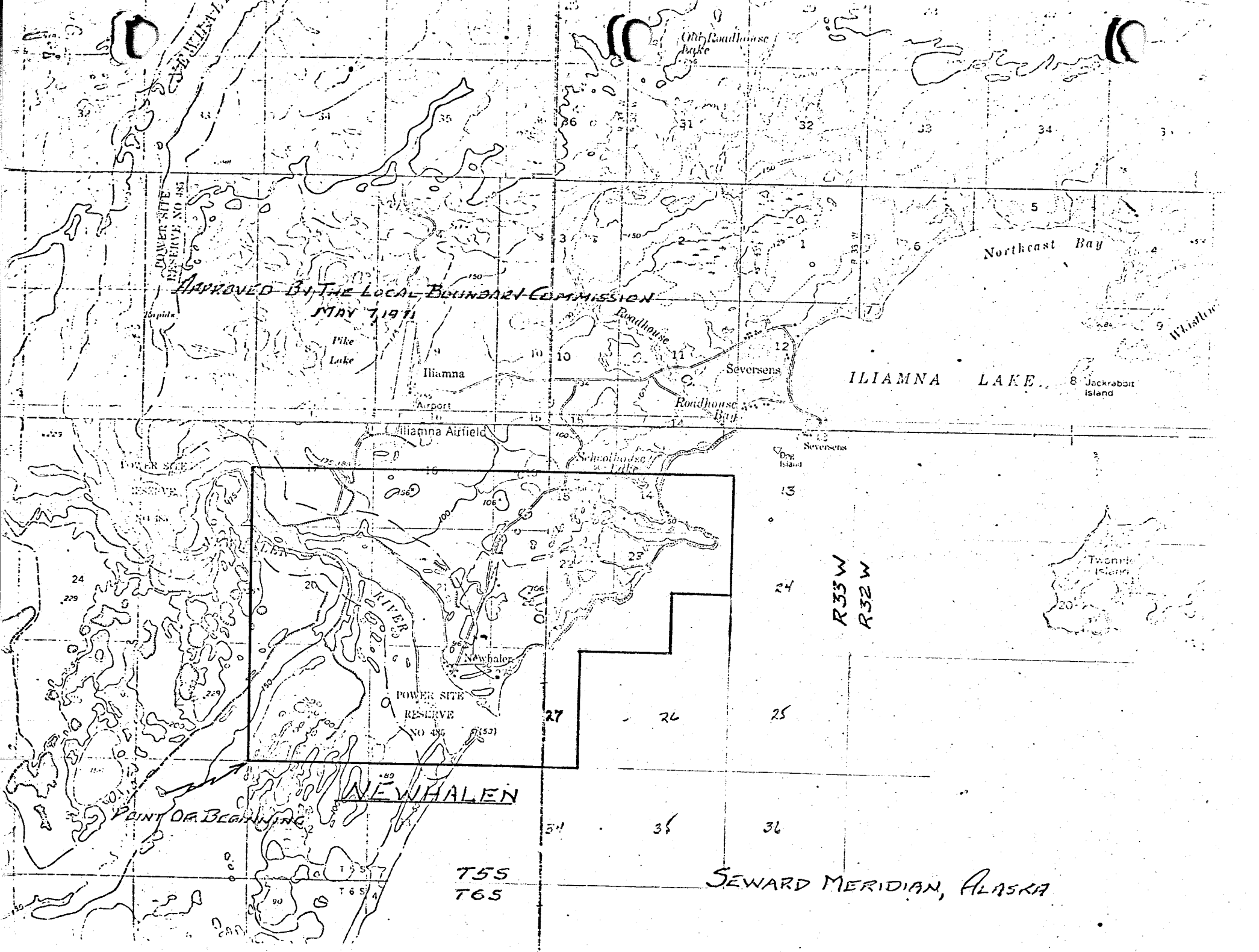
