CERTIFICATE

I, ROBERT W. WARD, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022 an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Pilot Station, Alaska, was held on September 23, 1969, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 47 for and 0 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Pilot Station is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

From a point bearing N4°00'E, a distance of 0.980 miles from USLM No. 2041, which shall be designated as Corner No. 1 and which is the point of beginning; thence by retes and bounds:

S45°00'W 2.159 miles to Corner No. 2; thence S 45°00'E 0.871 miles to Corner No. 3; thence N45°00'E 2.159 miles to Corner No. 4; thence N45°00'W 0.871 miles to Corner No. 1, the true point of beginning and containing 1.880 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on September 23, 1969, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
