CERTIFICATE

I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 15.15.450, 29.10.022 and 29.18.110 an election for the incorporation of a second class city known as Port Heiden, Alaska, was held on October 10, 1972, within the boundaries of said proposed area for the incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 21 for and 1 against.

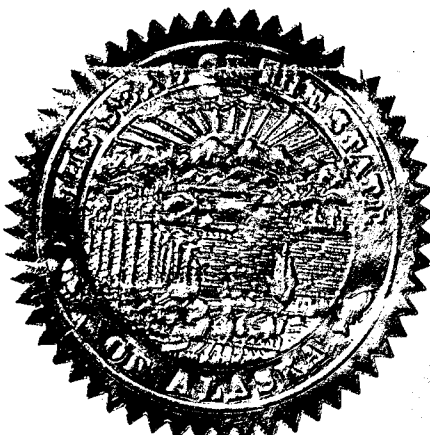
THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the second class by Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the point where the South boundary of Section 16, Unsurveyed T38S, R59W, Seward Meridian, Alaska, State of Alaska, intersects the mean low tide of the Port Heiden area of Bristol Bay; thence East to the SE corner of Section 17, Unsurveyed T38S, R58W; thence North to the NE corner of Section 8, Unsurveyed T37S, R58W; thence West to the point where the North boundary of Section 9, Unsurveyed T37S, R59W, intersects the mean low tide of the Port Heiden area of Bristol Bay; thence southerly along the meander of the Port Heiden area of Bristol Bay to the point of beginning, containing 47 square miles, more or less.

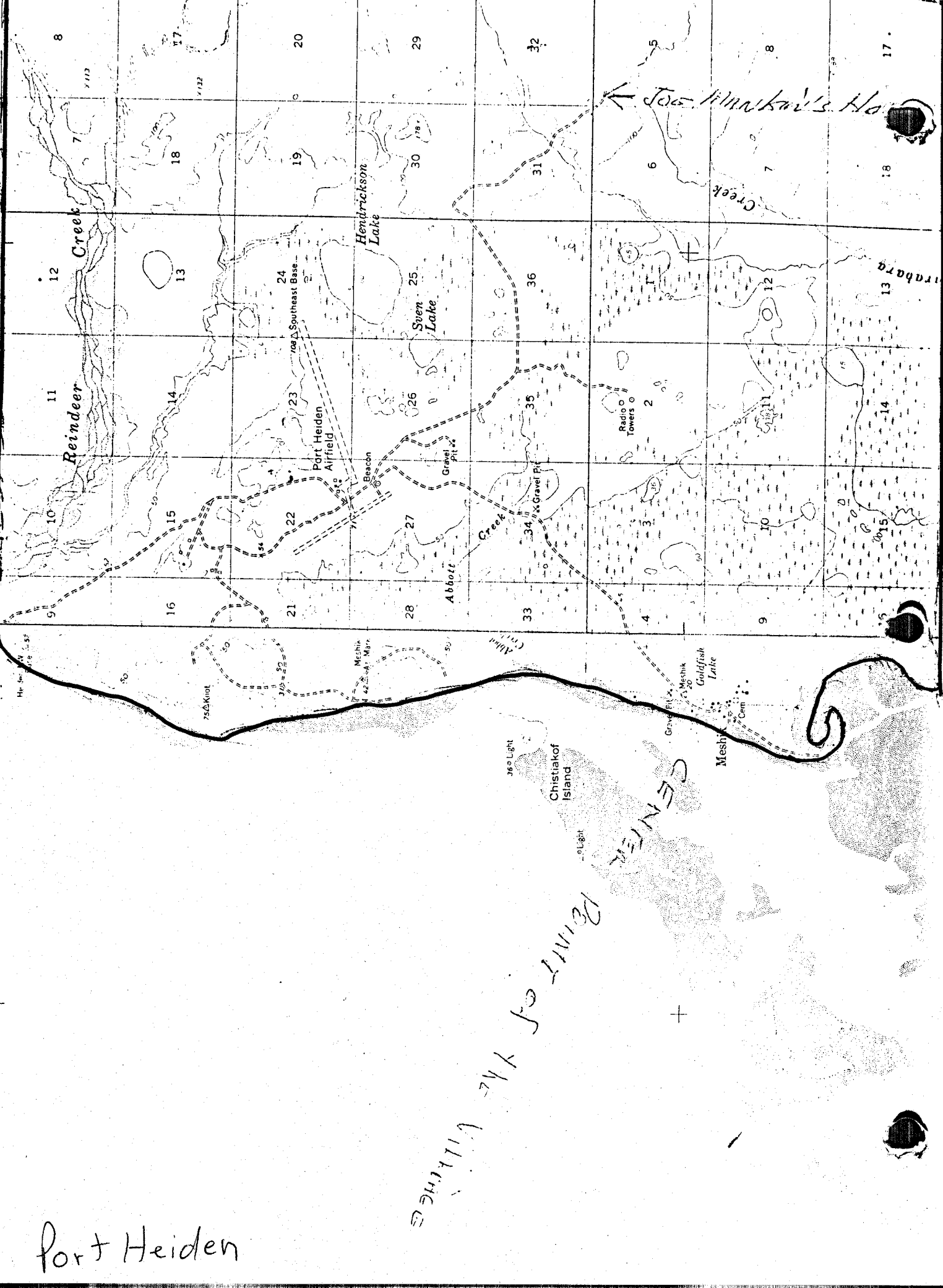
