I, LOWELL THOMAS, JR., LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 15.15.450. 29.18.110 an election for the incorporation of a second class city known as Quinhagak, Alaska, was held on January 21, 1975, within the boundaries of said proposed area for the incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 92 for and 7 against.

AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast for enactment of a 1% Sales Tax. The vote was 76 for and 23 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Quinhagak is incorporated as a second class city by Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:


Beginning at a point where the mean low water line of Kuskokwim Bay intersects with the section line, extended, common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, Unsurveyed T5S, R74W, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence east to the NE corner of Section 9, T5S, R74W; thence south to the SE corner of Section 16, T5S, R74W; thence west along the section line common to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, T5S, R74W to the point where it intersects with the mean low water line of Kuskokwim Bay; thence north along the mean low water line of Kuskokwim Bay to the point of beginning, containing six square miles more or less.
