CERTIFICATE

I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 15.15.450, 29,18,120 an election for the incorporation of a second class city known as Ruby, Alaska, was held on September 25, 1973, within the boundaries of said proposed area for the incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 28 for and 1 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Ruby is incorporated as a second class city by Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the point where 64°, 45'N latitude intersects the south bank of the Yukon River; thence true south three miles to a point; thence true west three miles to a point; thence true north to a point intersecting the south bank of the Yukon River; thence east northeast along the meander of the south bank of the Yukon River to the point of beginning containing seven square miles, more or less.
