CERTIFICATE

I, STEPHEN A. McALPINE, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.18.110, an election for the proposed incorporation of a second class city known as St. George, Alaska, was held on August 30, 1983 within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation.

AND THAT, the boundaries of the proposed city of St. George are as follows:

All the territory contained within the 3 mile perimeter surrounding St. George Island of the Pribilof group at Latitude 56° 35 minutes north and Longitude 169° 35 minutes west.

AND THAT, a majority of the votes cast were in favor of the proposal to incorporate St. George. The votes were tallied as follows:
