# CERTIFICATE

I, ROBERT W. WARD, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022 an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Savoonga, Alaska, was held on September 23, 1969, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 28 for and 25 against.

AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast against enactment of a 3% sales tax. The vote was 27 against and 15 for.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Savoonga is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Section 10, Unsurveyed T21S, R61W, Kateel River Meridian, Alaska; thence West to the northeast corner of Section 18; thence South to the southeast corner of said Section 18; thence West to southwest corner of Section 14, Unsurveyed T21S, R62W; thence North along the west boundary of Section 14 to its intersection with the meander of the Bering Sea; thence in a northeasterly, easterly, and southeasterly direction along the meander of the Bering Sea to its intersection with the east boundary of Section 10, Unsurveyed T21S, R61W; thence South to the southeast corner of Section 10, Unsurveyed T21S, R61W, the point of beginning, containing 6.0 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on September 23, 1969, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

- Gordon Iya
- Larry Kava
- Fred Okoomealingok
- Jerry Wongittilin, Sr.

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
