ORDER CALLING ELECTION

The petition of certain residents of the village of Saxman, Alaska, praying for the incorporation of that village as a municipality of the second class, coming regularly before me in open court, and it appearing from the testimony of witnesses that such incorporation is for the best interests of such community, and no one appearing in opposition thereto:

It is hereby ordered and adjudged that it is for the best interests of the town of Saxman, Alaska, to be incorporated as a municipality of the second class, to be known as Saxman, Alaska, with the following external boundaries:


Beginning at the shore line of Tongass Narrows on the easterly side a distance of 40 chains northwesterly of U.S.L.M. No. 5 for Corner No. 1; running through a concrete monument on said shore line N 45 degrees 36'E a distance of 80 chains to Corner No. 2; thence S 44 degrees 24' E a distance of 75.71 chains to Corner No. 3; thence S 45 degrees 36'W a distance of approximately 76 chains to the meander line of Tongass Narrows to Corner No. 4; thence following the meander line of the mean low tide to Corner No. 1, the place of beginning, containing an area approximately one mile square, but not more than 640 acres.

It is further ordered that on the 26th day of October, 1929, an election shall be held in the usual polling place in the said town of Saxman, Alaska, wherein it shall be determined whether such community desires to be incorporated as a municipality of the second class by ratifying this Order: and that Peter McKay, Johnny K. Williams and Henry Denny, Jr., shall act as judges of said election; that by separate ballot at such election three trustees of said town of Saxman shall be chosen as provided by Chapter 99, SIA 1929.

It is further ordered that copies of this order shall be posted in three public places within the town of Saxman to serve as election notices.
