CERTIFICATE

I, ROBERT W. WARD, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022 an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Shishmaref, Alaska, was held on June 24, 1969, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 46 for and 6 against.

AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast for enactment of a 1% sales tax. The vote was 39 for and 12 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Shishmaref is incorporated as a fourth class city with authority to enact a 1% sales tax;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

The entire land area of the barrier island known as Shishmaref Island, Alaska, located at latitude 66° 15' N and longitude 166° 05' W bounded on its Northwestern side by the Chukchi Sea, on its Southeastern side by the Shishmaref Inlet, and on both extremes by short unnamed channels, containing 2.47 square miles more or less.

AND THAT on June 24, 1969, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

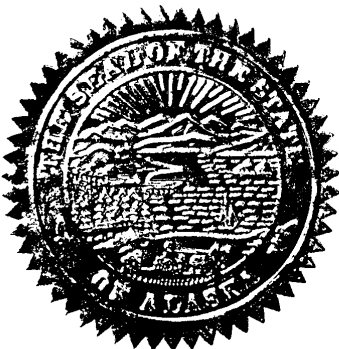

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
