I, LEE McANERNEY, COMMISSIONER of the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, do hereby certify that the Local Boundary Commission recommendation entitled:

"Recommendation to correct errors in the
Boundary Description of the City of Shungnak, Alaska"

became effective on March 4, 1976.

An order of incorporation for the City of Shungnak, Alaska by the Superior Court, Second Judicial District at Nome, Alaska was filed in May 1967. Subsequent to incorporation it was found that the boundary description for the newly incorporated fourth class city was in error to wit:

the description embraced an area surrounding the village of Kobuk.

The Local Boundary Commission has determined that the error is of a ministerial rather than of a decisional nature.

A majority of the members of the Commission voted to recommend to the Legislature the corrected boundary description.

THE COMMISSION'S recommendation was presented to the State Legislature pursuant to Article X Section 12 of the Constitution of the State of Alaska.

THE SECOND SESSION of the Ninth State Legislature received the Commission's

recommendation on January 19, 1976, the second day of the Legislative Session. No resolution of disapproval was introduced.

THEREFORE, the Local Boundary Commission's "Recommendation to Correct Errors in the Local Boundary Description of the City of Shungnak, Alaska" became effective on March 4, 1976, the forty-sixth day after presentation to the Legislature. The boundary description of the City of Shungnak is as described in the Local Boundary Commission's recommendation to wit:

CITY OF SHUNGNAK

Beginning at the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, Unsurveyed T17N, R8E; Kateel River Meridian, Alaska; thence W to the NW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, UT17N, R8E; thence S to the SW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, UT17N, R8E; thence E to the SE corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, UT17N, R8E; thence N to the point of beginning, containing 8 square miles more or less.
