CERTIFICATE

I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022, an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Tenakee Springs, Alaska, was held on September 14, 1971, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 36 for and 4 against.

AND THAT a majority of votes were cast for enactment of a 1% sales tax. The vote was 28 for and 10 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Tenakee Springs is incorporated as a fourth class city with the authority to enact a 1% sales tax;

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Tenakee Springs is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES:

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the SE corner of Section 20, T47S, R64E, (projected), Copper River Meridian, Alaska; thence N to the NE corner of Section 17, T47S, R64E; thence W to the SE corner of Section 7, T47S, R63E; thence N to the NE corner of Section 7, T47S, R63E; thence W to the NW corner of Section 12, T47S, R62E; thence S to the SW corner of Section 13, T47S, R62E; thence E to the NE corner of Section 19, T47S, R63E; thence S to the SW corner of Section 20, T47S, R63E; thence E to the point of beginning, containing 18.0 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on September 14, 1971, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

- Charles C. Thomas


AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
