

CERTIFICATE



I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022, an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Toksook Bay, Alaska, was held on March 21, 1972, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 65 for and 3 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Toksook Bay is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES:

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the NE corner of Section 35, Unsurveyed T6N, R90W, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence in a westerly direction to the NW corner of the SW 1/4 of Section 4, Unsurveyed T5N, R91W; thence in a southerly direction to the NE corner of the SW 1/4 of Section 22, Unsurveyed T4N, R92W; thence in an easterly direction to the SE corner of the NW 1/4 of Section 1, Unsurveyed T4N, R91W; thence northerly to the point of beginning, containing 69.5 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on March 21, 1972, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

- Paul Agimuk
- John Jumbo
- John Lawrence
- Jobe Nevak
- John Paul

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
