CERTIFICATE

I, ROBERT W. WARD, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022 an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as White Mountain, Alaska, was held on June 24, 1969, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 17 for and 1 against.

AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast for enactment of a 1% sales tax. The vote was 12 for and 6 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of White Mountain is incorporated as a fourth class city with authority to enact a 1% sales tax;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at a point about 2,640 feet in a southeasterly direction from a monument on the summit of White Mountain, at Post No. 1, which is located on the bank of the steam-boat channel of Fish River and further marked by two witness posts; thence northerly about 4,000 feet to Post No. 2; thence northwesterly about 3,960 feet to Post No. 3; thence westerly about 7,040 feet to Post No. 4; thence southwesterly about 2,640 feet to Post No. 5; thence southerly about 2,640 feet to Post No. 6; thence easterly about 10,560 feet to Post No. 1, the place of beginning, containing 1,200 acres more or less.

AND THAT on June 24, 1969, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

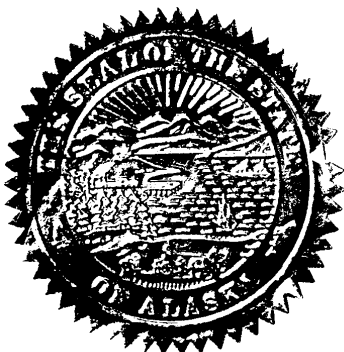

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
