I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022, an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Golovin, Alaska, was held on March 2, 1971, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 26 for and 1 against.

AND THAT a majority of the votes were cast for enactment of a 2% sales tax. The vote as 16 for a nd 11 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Golovin is incorporated as a fourth class city with authority to enact a 2% sales tax;

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Golovin is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES;

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at a point at 'the intersection of Latitude 64°35' N and Longitude 162°58'20" West; thence West to the intersection of the mean low water line of the Golovin Lagoon at Latitude 64°35' N; thence southerly and south-westerly along the meandering mean low water line of the Golovin Lagoon, continuing around to an easterly direction along the meander&g mean low water line of the Golovin Bay to a point where the Longitude 162°58'20" West intersects the mean low water line of the Golovin Bay; thence North to the point of beginning, containing 4.0 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.



