

To the Alaska Local Boundary Commission,

In regards to the annexation of the Mansfield peninsula, I would like to express my support in favor of the Xunna Borough. If Article X. Sec. 3 of the Alaska Constitution requires boroughs to encompass areas and populations with common interest, then I would assume that remote wilderness cabins off grid would be have more in common with Xunna than Juneau. This can be attested to by most if not all the private land owners in this proposed borough site. The Xunna Borough is preferable not only because it is more in line with the interests of the property owners of this area but if it becomes out of line with the remote off grid property owners, they will have a larger proportional voice to affect future decisions of the area that directly affect them, as opposed to the CBJ which doesn't seem to have much interest or incentive to listen to the relatively small number of property owners concerns.
