After some additional thought, it would be not be appropriate to use the north shore of Tenakee Inlet for the southern boundary of the proposed Hoonah borough. Should the Hoonah borough be expanded, the southern boundary should be the drainage divide north of the shore of Tenakee Inlet rather than the shoreline itself. It would be best to keep any reference to Hoonah out of Tenakee Inlet.
