## **About the Newtok Planning Group**

The Newtok Planning Group (NPG) was organized in May 2006 when members of Newtok's tribal council requested assistance from the State of Alaska with the village relocation effort. Representatives from state and federal agencies and non-governmental organizations began meeting regularly with Newtok's tribal leadership to coordinate assistance for the relocation of the community to a new village site, Mertarvik, on Nelson Island. The unique partnership of the NPG has worked with Newtok since the first relocation planning and early infrastructure development, collaborating to provide advice, support, and critical problem-solving for Newtok's relocation to Mertarvik.
