

# Crooked Creek Activity Report


## Community Overview

Region: Kuskokwim River Delta

Local Governments: Village Council



Nearly all homes lack plumbing, and residents haul water and honeybuckets. A new well provides treated water. A new washeteria has been completed, however the sewage lagoon is not yet functioning. The school, store, and three homes have individual wells, septic tanks and plumbing. The school septic drainfield is failing. The community needs a new water tank and landfill with access road.

## General Information

There has been no activities during this quarter. Efforts to make contacts with the new tribal president were fruitless.

## Anticipated Activity

Leroy Seppilu will be transferring to the Nome Office effective September 1, 2001, and become responsible for the communities in that region. The status of Crooked Creek will be reevaluated before it is assigned to other RUBA staff.
