A Memorandum of Agreement has been signed between the City and Native Village of Mekoryuk/IRA for operation and maintenance of the utility. The tribe is going to run the utility and is in transition of taking over the utility operation and Maintenance. The city and tribe are still in discussion stage as to what the MOA means to both entities.

RUBA Activity This Quarter

RUBA staff assisted the tribal bookkeeper in completing a working budget for the city. The city council approved and passed the FY05 budget after a public meeting. The city signed a MOA for the tribal council to take over the utility. RUBA staff will continue to work with the city and offer assistance to the tribal council.

All financial procedures are in place under the tribal bookkeeper with assistance from the city clerk. They are having the Tribal contract an auditor to reconcile past accounts under the city, since there obviously had been no bank reconciliations done under the city.
