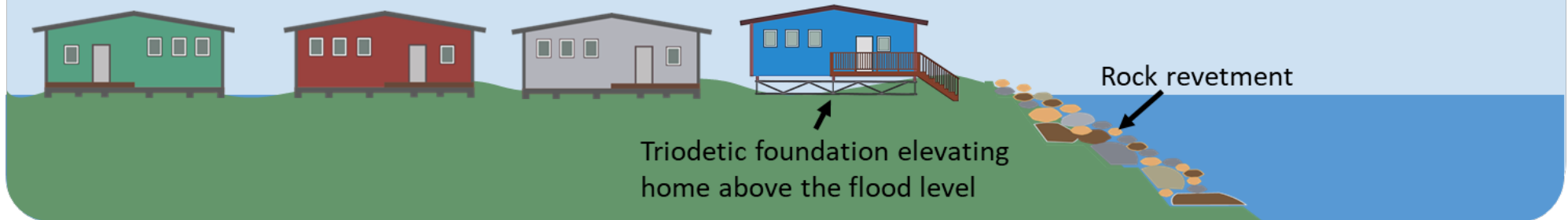
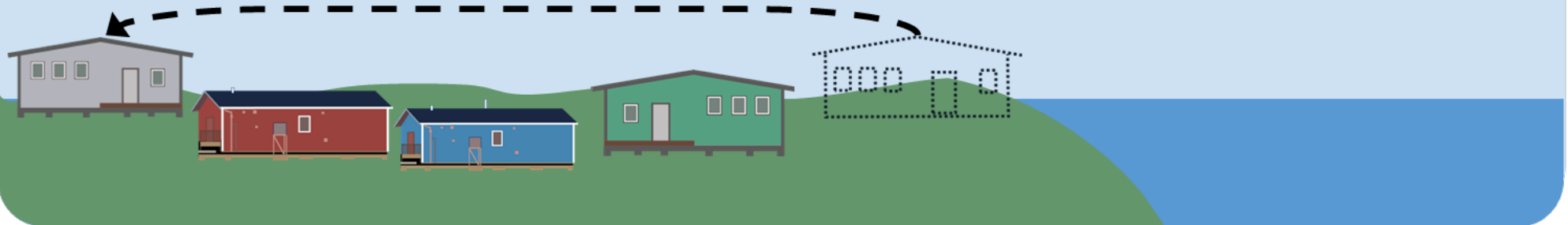


Community-Driven Responses to Natural Hazards

Protection-in-Place: The use of shoreline protection measures and other controls to minimize impacts. These measures will allow the community to remain at its current location.



Managed Retreat: Moving a portion of the community away from hazard-prone areas to locations in the community or adjacent to the current site. In order to successfully retreat, the community needs developable land nearby.



Relocation: Moving the community to a new location that is not connected to the current site. Relocation is the option of last resort because it is the most expensive, labor-intensive, and time-consuming option.
