CEASE AND DESIST ORDERS ISSUED

Investigation established that Tauriainen did architectural work in the process of doing the design work for the project. A cease and desist order was sent to Tauriainen, who has requested a hearing on the matter. (Opened 04/08/03)
- Allegation that Mike Tauriainen, a Civil Engineer, worked outside the scope of education, training and licensure by doing architectural design work on a building. Investigation established that Tauriainen's design work exceeded the scope of his license as a civil engineer. A cease and desist order was sent to Tauriainen, who has requested a hearing on the matter. (Opened 04/08/03)

OTHER CASES CLOSED:

O102-05-3

Allegation that an engineer certified a septic system as installed per Division of Environmental Conservation requirements. Investigation revealed the system was installed under a code that was not as specific as currently used. The engineer could have written the report in a manner that clearly specified which code was in effect when the system was installed. There was insufficient evidence to substantiate the allegation. This closure was coordinated with AELS Board Member Boyd Brownfield. (Closed 06/28/05)
