- Official transcripts
- One FD-258 fingerprint card
- \$260 fee

 - APPROVED ALASKA BASIC COMPETENCY EXAM (BCE)
- **END-OF-YEAR TWO**
 - ALASKA STUDIES & ALASKA MULTICULTURAL COURSEWORK
- **PRIOR TO PROFESSIONAL**
 - PROGRAM VERIFICATION
 - CONTENT AREA EXAM
