Until satisfactory documentation of deficient CE is received	<b>\$2,000 MAXIMUM AMOUNT comprised of two elements \$1,500</b> fine for falsification on the application (up to <b>\$2,350</b> of <i>this amount may be suspended based on the gravity of the offense</i> ) <b>plus \$50</b> per credit hour lacking up to <b>\$500</b> maximum. (see minutes December 15, 2000 BD MTG) <b>This motion was superceded by the October 2012 resolution - see below</b>
Continuing Competency Violations 10/1/2012	<b>RESOLVED that the Board of Nursing for the State of Alaska, under authority 08.01.075(a)(8) establishes the following civil fines against licensees who do not meet continuing competency regulations per Article 6 or 12 AAC 44.825: A fine of \$2,500 for ANPs and CRNAs, \$2,000 for RNs, \$1,500 for LPNs, and \$500 for CNAs. This goes into effect beginning with the 2012 renewal audit cycle.</b>				
Chemical dependency or drug abuse issues	<b>A standard 5 year probation on Consent Agreements</b> , with the provision that the licensee could petition for early release from the Consent Agreement by presenting to the Board appropriate written documentation of successful treatment.
