

Notice of Proposed Regulation Changes – Board of Marine Pilots (MAR), proposing to update various regulations by defining the term “length overall.” Notice Published: May 3, 2016.

Answers to questions 1 through 4 are answers to common questions regarding proposed regulation changes. The period for written comments ends June 2, 2016. To be considered, comments must be submitted by 4:30 p.m. on June 2, 2016.

Regulatory Questions

1 5/3/2016	What will these proposed regulation changes do?
Answer: 12 AAC 56.990(a) – create a definition for “length overall” and “overall length.”	
2 5/3/2016	What is the public need or purpose for these proposed regulation changes?
Answer: Clears up ambiguity.	
3 5/3/2016	What will the known or estimated costs of the new regulation changes be to a private person, another state agency, or a municipality?
Answer: None known.	
4 5/3/2016	What are the positive and negative consequences as a result of these proposed regulation changes to the public or private person, business, or organization?
Answer: There are no negative consequences as a result of the regulation changes being proposed. The positive results will be (1) to clear up ambiguity; and (2) correction of a pilot station latitude.
