

BOARD OF MARINE PILOTS

Minutes of Conference Call
May 26, 1981

In accordance with AS 08.04.040 and AS 44.62.310, a scheduled Conference Call meeting of the Board of Marine Pilots was held at 3:00 p.m. (PDT) on May 26, 1981.

Present, and constituting a quorum of the board, were:

Also present were Marjorie Odland, Regulations Specialist, and Lisa Julian, Licensing Examiner, from the Division of Occupational Licensing.

Mr. Treager convened the meeting at 3:18 p.m. (PDT). Ms. Julian called the roll and all board members were present.

Mr. Treager explained the purpose of the Conference Call was to vote on the adoption of an emergency regulation to provide for a June 1, 1981 effective date for the recently adopted Southeast tariff.

Ms. Odland explained that the Southeast Alaska Pilots tariff proposal requested an effective date of June 1, 1981. The Board of Marine Pilots held a hearing on the proposal on April 16, 1981 and agreed to an across-the-board rate increase of 12.75%.

In the process of filing the granted tariff increase, as provided in 12 AAC 56.158, the effective date of the tariff would be 30 days after filing by the Lieutenant Governor. Before filing, she explained, it was necessary to obtain legal assistance from the Department of Law. This was not accomplished in time to allow for filing 30 days before June 1.

Since the Southeast Alaska Pilots Association had not requested an increase in tariff rates since 1978, and since they were denied consideration of an increase in tariff rates in December 1980, the board determined it would be an undue financial hardship to delay the effective date of the increased tariff.
