The wording for "course work" throughout. Additionally, I propose to repeal 12 AAC19.320(b)(2) and (3), and to amend 12 AAC 19.110(g) to read: To be scheduled for and take an examination, an applicant must meet the requirements of this section. An individual approved by the Board under AS 08.63.110 for a license for supervised practice may schedule and take the Professional Examination Service's Examination in Marital and Family Therapy by requesting a test number from the division through email.
